## **Parental Supervision Agreement**

I understand that it is my responsibility to protect my family and to help them receive the best of what the Internet has to offer. In that spirit, I agree to the following:

- 1. <u>I will listen calmly</u>: If my child comes to me with a problem related to his online experiences I promise not to get angry but to do my best to help my child resolve this situation.
- 2. <u>I will set a good example</u>: I will not spend too much time online, nor will I encourage illegal or unethical behaviour there.
- 3. <u>I will be reasonable</u>:I will set reasonable rules and expectations for Internet usage. These rules will be based on advice from appropriate authorities and experts (and not on horror stories I hear from irresponsible sources). I will establish reasonable consequences for lapses in judgement on the part of my child.
- 4. <u>I will accord my child dignity</u>: I will respect the friendships that he may make online as I would his offline friends. I will not laugh at him for caring about strangers he's never met.
- 5. <u>I will not be a snoop</u>: I promise not to go further than I need to in order to ensure my child's safety. I will not read diaries or journals, nor will I inspect e-mails or transmissions from other relatives or trusted offline friends.
- 6. <u>No drastic measures:</u> No matter what happens, I understand that the Internet is an important tool that could be essential to his success in school or business, and I promise not to ban it entirely.
- 7. <u>I will be involved</u>: I will spend time with my child and be a part of his online activities and relationships just as I do offline.

I have read and understand the above guidelines. I understand that my co-operation and help is needed as my child navigates this new universe. I support his efforts to be responsible and safe, and encourage his use of this resource.
